



WATCH HILL YACHT CLUB CRITERIA FOR HALF MODEL DONATIONS

WHYC Members are invited to commission and donate half models of their yachts or yachts owned by deceased or other Members.

The models will be mounted directly on the walls without backboards. Brass nameplates, provided by the donor, will be mounted on the wall below each model. The style and wording of each nameplate is specified below.

A model collection directory will be displayed near the models describing the particulars of each yacht.

Donors are responsible for contracting with model makers, paying all costs of making, preparing and shipping the models, meeting the WHYC criteria for acceptance of models and producing a document describing the yacht, its history, builder, year built, dimensions, ownership and characteristics, to be included in the model collection directory.

Donors may contract with model makers of their choice and it is recommended that donors vet the model maker and view previous models made by that maker.

Donors will be required to execute and deliver a Deed of Gift in the form annexed.

CRITERIA

1. Half models are to show the starboard side and are to be painted to correspond to the colors of the yacht.
2. Half models are to be constructed to 1:24 (1/2 inch : 1 foot) scale.
3. The models are to be half hulls only, stopping at the toe rail, showing no superstructure, coaming, spars, etc. (except bowsprits).
4. No backboards are to be used. The half models will be mounted directly on the walls.
5. Stripes are to be painted rather than taped.
6. Appendages (keels, rudders, bowsprits, etc.) on the model shall be reinforced to avoid breakage over time.
7. The back of each model shall be provided with two mounting holes parallel to the waterline.
8. Models already in the WHYC collection may be grandfathered.
9. Uniform brass nameplates for mounting on the wall beneath the model shall be provided by the donor as follows: rectangular, no larger than 2" x 4" in size, bearing yacht name, type of yacht, year built, length overall, and name of owner.
10. The name of the yacht and the name of the donor shall be written on the back of each model.
11. Only models of yachts belonging now or formerly to current or deceased WHYC Members will be accepted.
