The Watch Hill Yacht Club offers reciprocity to any bona fide Yacht Club unless that club is within a 25-mile range or there is a special agreement. The WHYC has special agreements with Masons Island, Fishers Island, Ram Island, and the Wadawanuck Club, as well as the Stonington Harbor Yacht Club.

- 1.) Reciprocal privileges extend to members arriving by boat. The WHYC parking lot is too small and congested to accommodate our own members, so we **cannot** extend parking privileges to any reciprocal club member;
- 2.) Reciprocal club members must always fly their yacht club burgees when approaching, and at our docks at all times; there is a 2 -hour maximum stay, longer with prior permission.
- 3.) All visiting boats must hail the launch office via **VHF Channel 10** for docking instructions. No telephone calls will be accepted.
- 4.) Visiting boats may be instructed to go to a mooring and rafting may be allowed at the discretion of the launch office.
- 5.) Overnight or after hours docking is **not permitted**.
- 6.) During Junior Program Sailing hours (9:00am to 4:00pm, Monday thru Friday) docking is not permitted on either side of the floating dock.
- 7.) All dinghy visits must be at the dinghy dock on the east side of the WHYC.

DINING & BAR: Please introduce yourself and show your **membership card (required)** to the WHYC representative on duty upstairs;

Lunch: Noon to 2:00 PM Tue, Thu, Fri, & Sat beginning mid-June to Labor Day; reservations not required but suggested;

Dinner: 6:30-8:30 PM on Tue., Thu., Fri., Sat.; reservations are not accepted until **4:00PM** on the day requested, and due to our limited facilities, parties must be restricted to 4 or fewer. Due to the small size and popularity of our dining facilities, dinner is sometimes not possible for reciprocal members;

Payment Methods: All payments must be made by **cash, check, or Visa or MasterCard**; to expedite quicker service, we can accept a maximum of two checks per table;

Bar: Beverage service is available starting at **Noon mid-June until Labor Day**;

Attire: Proper attire is required at all times; **jackets** are required for dinner; at all other times shirts with collars and Bermuda shorts are permissible; women are asked to please dress accordingly;

Cell Phones - Use of cell phones is prohibited at all times on the third level of the Clubhouse including the balconies.

Tobacco Usage: All tobacco use, including smoking, is **prohibited** at the Clubhouse facility, including all docks and balconies.

Miscellaneous: With prior permission, it is possible to come alongside and take on water or load/unload passengers; but only for a short time period. Ice is available at the Town Dock nearby. Clearly Marked Trash and recycling containers are located inside the east side of the dock...

NOTE: minors under 21 are not allowed on the third level unless accompanied by an adult.
